The Great War will be acknowledged by the Library through a dynamic light installation titled "The lamps are going out all over Europe. We shall not see them lit again in our lifetime"

The animated light show will project onto the 1937 Reading Room the names and photographic portraits of Trinity College Dublin students, staff and alumni who fell in WW1.

Also on Wednesday 18 November the Library will present a series of *Lightning* talks entitled *The Decade of Commemoration: showcasing resources and new pathways for research*, as part of "The Library of the Future; the Future of the Library", a programme of activities for 2015-2016.

The lunch time event will introduce a series of innovative Library initiatives responding to the Decade of Commemoration and designed to showcase the Library's unique and distinct collections. These initiatives include the *Great War Revisited* online exhibition in partnership with Google Cultural Institute; The *Changed Utterly* 1916 blog project; and the forthcoming *Fit as fiddles and as hard as nails* war-diaries resource. The projects use online platforms to alert researchers to the rich research potential of the Library's Special Research Collections. This event will be relevant to both teachers and students interested in exploring the research potential of the Library's collections.
